

The "Time is Now" rally.

On 26th June 2019 about 12,000 people gathered at a mass rally in Westminster to put pressure on politicians and urge them to act. At 2pm they rang alarm clocks, mobile phone alarms and sirens, and cheered loudly to symbolise "the time is now" Their message was loud and clear:²

"It's time to end the UK's contribution to climate change and pass ambitious laws that create a healthier environment for nature and people." 1

The Liberal Democrat, Sir Ed Davey, was among 195 MP's who met their constituents. He said it was absolutely clear that the British public was telling politicians to get tough on climate change.²
